IN A VERY CLOSE CONTEST, INDIAN RETHIN KUMAR BEATS HIKARU TAKAHASHI 7-5, 7-5, KEEPING EVERY INDIAN HOPE ALIVE IN THE ONGOING ITF J200 TOURNAMENT. ITF J200'S QUALIFIER, CAHIR WARIK PLAYED HI S HEART OUT & ENDURED A MARATHON AGAINST THE SECOND SEEDED AMIR MIKUSHEV WHICH HE EVENTUALLY LOST TO THE LATTER BY 4-6,6-4,5-7. AAYUSH BHATT & AMIR MILUSHEV WHO BOTH BROKE INTO THE TOP 100 OF THE ITF DOUBLES RANKING FORMED A DEADLY COMBINATION AS THEY WENT ON TO WIN 6-3,3-6,10-6 IN A MOUTH-WATERING TIE AGAINST KE HAU & POONTHONG KOMOPISUT. THE BRITISH REPRESENTATIVE ALLEGRA DAVIES CAME FROM BEHIND 4-6, 6-3, 6-1 TO BEAT THE KAZAKH DANA BAIDAULET AS THE CROWD CHEERS HER ON FOR STRONG DISPLAY OF RESILIENCY





CHAMPION OF THE RECENTLY CONCLUDED ITF J100, CHANDIGARH, DONGHYUN HWANG (KOR) HOPE OF WINNING SUCCESSIVE ITF JUNIORS EVENT WAS CRUSHED IN THE HANDS OF HIS RUSSIAN OPPONENT IVAN IUTKINAS AS HE FAILED TO HOLD ON TO HIS FIRST SET LEAD BY 7-6(6), 0-6, 4-6.AMIR MILUSHEV (UZB) WAS UP AGAINST THE TWO TIME J5 ZOUK CHAMPION & AMIR COULDN'T KEEP UP WITH THE PACE UP OF THE AGILE TIMOFEI WHO WENT ON TO WIN 6-2,5-7,7-5 IN A TIGHT CONTEST.

REFLECTING ON THE MILESTONES ACHIEVED BY THE TOP-SEEDED ADITHYA, WHO HAS LARGELY DOMINATED THE TOURNAMENT SAW HIS FATE CRUSHED OUT BY THE KOREAN OPPONENT JANGJUN KIM, WHO EDGE PAST ADITHYA IN STRAIGHT SETS BY 7-5, 6-3 . IVAN RUTKIN SEES OFF HIS DOUBLES PARTNER TIMOFEI AS THE LATTER SUCCUMBED TO HIS INJURIES WHICH HE WAS TRAILING BY 2-6,0-2 BEFORE HE DECIDED TO CALL OFF

In Boys double, the tournament favourite Ayush Bhat & Amir lived up to their expectations & struck an instant rapport since the commencement of the ITJ J200 as they cruised past the second-seeded Kim & Nasridinov by 6-2,6-4 in a dream start to their 2023 campaign. seeded Jangjun Kim of Korea was unfailingly clear about his objective : he was here to win. He came from one set down beat his Russian to opponent Ivan Rutkin by 6-7,6-4,7-5 as the former showed endless an & energy great determination to cap off with a win. The Korean ran a marathon to achieve his first trophy in the year 2023 & sets a tantalizing scene for the season ahead.

Vlada Mincheva (Russia) capped off her wild, thrilling ride to her maiden ITF J200 title by withstanding an intense challenge from the topseeded Ashton Bower as she defeats her American opponent 6-3,6-2 to capture the ITF J200 title in the capital of India. The 15 year old, left-hander Vlada has won the heart of everyone with her allround ability & elegance on court.
