## ***Roland-Garros Junior Wildcard Series 2018.***

### **OVERVIEW**

Roland Garros Series-Junior Wild Card Tournament by Longines is the junior tournament on red clay which offers a wildcard for the 2018 French Open Junior Tournament. It will first take place separately in China, India, Brazil, South Korea, Japan & USA. After the first round of competition in each country, the champions will come to Paris for the final round, and the final champion will win this wildcard.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

The Roland Garros Series-Junior Wild card Series event of Indian Circuit will be invitational for top 8 boys and 8 girls. They will be selected on the basis of AITA Under 18 Ranking available as on the AITA website as on 2nd April 2018. A list so compiled will be available on AITA website by 16<sup>th</sup> April 2018.

All players are required to send their confirmation in writing by 16<sup>th</sup> April 2018 12:00 Indian time on [montes@aitatennis.com](mailto:montes@aitatennis.com). If the selected players do not intimate their acceptance by deadline, next player in the list so prepared will be accepted.

If the ranking of the winner of the RDVRG in India is 45 or higher at the time of the entry closing of Roland Garros, the ticket to Paris will be allocated to the runner up. If the runner up's ranking is 45 or higher at the time of the entry closing, the ticket to Paris will be allocated to the second runner up and so on.

<b>FORMAT OF PLAY</b>	<p>Singles – Best of three (3) tie break sets. Play-off matches for the third and fourth position will also be played. Format would be 2 tie break sets with a match tie break if it becomes one set all.</p> <p>There shall be “NO LET” rule in place for all the matches during the tournament</p>
<b>CONDUCT AND BEHAVIOUR</b>	The tournament will be played under the Grand Slam code of conduct
<b>ENTRY FEE</b>	30 € (EURO THIRTY) (INR RS 2450/-)
