Fed Cup makes Rome debut

Fed Cup by BNP Paribas will be staged in Rome for the first time when the Foro Italico hosts the 2010 World Group semifinal between Italy and Czech Republic on 24-25 April. The tie will be played outdoors on red clay at the Stadio "Nicola Pietrangeli", with a venue capacity of 4,000.

The semifinal tie starts two weeks of international tennis at the Foro Italico, which will also hold the traditional ATP World Tour and Sony Ericsson WTA Tour events.

Italy and Czech Republic have met on six previous occasions, with the head-to-head score currently level. However Italy has won the last three ties between the two nations, most recently in 2005. The hosts are the defending champions, having claimed their second title by defeating USA in last year's Final. In the first round, Corrado Barazzutti's side claimed a comfortable 4-1 victory over Ukraine in Kharkiv.

The Czech team has won the title five times, with all its victories coming between 1975 and 1988. Czech Republic reached the semifinals with a 3-2 win over Germany in the first round in Brno, with the tie being decided by the doubles rubber.

In the other semifinal, USA faces Russia at the Birmingham-Jefferson Convention Complex Arena in Birmingham, Alabama. For further information, visit www.fedcup.com.

Bourgue and Puig win Gerdau Cup

Mathias Bourgue of France and Puerto Rico's Monica Puig won their first Grade A titles on the ITF Junior Circuit at the Gerdau Cup in Brazil at the weekend. Bourgue, who only turned 16 in January, won a Grade 5 tournament in Scotland last July but nothing suggested that he was ready to make the leap to a Grade A winner. He did it the hard way, playing three sets in his second round, third round, quarterfinal and semifinal matches. In the final he faced 11th seed Jiri Vesely of Czech Republic, who dropped just two games in their only previous meeting. However, Bourgue served notice of his rapid improvement in recent months by emerging a 63 76(2) winner.

Brazil had high hopes of a third consecutive local winner after Jose Pereira's victories in 2008 and 2009, but top seed Tiago Fernandes, the Australian Open champion, lost in straight sets to Colombia's Felix Mantilla in the second round.

In contrast to Bourgue, Puig's victory did not come as a surprise as the Puerto Rican had reached the final of the year's previous Grade A, the Casablanca Cup. She dropped just one set en route to the final, where she met the unseeded Jessica Pegula. The American had taken advantage of the defeat of top seed Jana Cepelova (SVK) to Agustina Sol Eskenazi (ARG) to reach her first major final. Pegula came close to a major upset, taking the first set against Puig and making her way to a second set tiebreak but Puig hit back strongly to win 26 76(5) 63.

The doubles events were dominated by Slovak Republic. Cepelova teamed up with Vivien Juhaszova to win the girls' title, defeating top seeds Puig and Veronica Cepede Royg (PAR). Filip Horansky and Jozef Kovalik took the boys' crown on a walkover after Diulio Beretta (PER) and Roberto Quiroz (ECU) had to withdraw due to an injury to Beretta.
