Countdown to Roland Garros

The 2010 Roland Garros championships begin this Sunday, 23 May, the fifth year the tournament has had a Sunday start. The opening day's play will see 16 men's and 16 women's matches scheduled on eight courts, including the three principal show courts. French players have received 12 of the 16 wild cards on offer, with Australia's Carsten Ball and Jarmila Groth, and Americans Ryan Sweeting and Christina McHale receiving wild cards thanks to reciprocal agreements with Tennis Australia and the USTA.

The Children of Roland Garros day, in which many of the players take part in one-set exhibition matches in aid of charity, will take place on Saturday 22 May. The men's qualifying tournament begins on Tuesday, with the 16 qualifiers emerging on Friday. Women's qualifying starts on Wednesday, with the 12 qualifiers also decided on Friday.

The draw for this year's men's and women's singles will take place on Friday 21 May at 11:30 local time (09:30 GMT), and appear live on the Roland Garros website: www.rolandgarros.org.

Puig and Fucsovics head Italian Open junior line-up

Monica Puig of Puerto Rico and Hungary's Marton Fucsovics top the bill at this week's Trofeo Bonfiglio ITF Grade A junior event in Milan, as the Italian clay court circuit comes to a climax.

Sixteen-year-old Puig has been in exceptional form this year, posting a 26-5 win-loss record that includes her first Grade A title at the Copa Gerdau in Brazil. Victory in Italy would cement her position as world No. 2 and ensure she is top seed at junior Roland Garros in the absence of junior world champion Kristina Mladenovic, who no longer competes on the ITF Junior Circuit.

World No. 3 Irina Khromacheva (RUS) poses the greatest threat to Puig, having claimed three titles already this year. However those wins have come on hard courts and the Russian, who turned 15 last week, has not played on clay since July last year. Other significant names in the girls' draw include 2009 junior Roland Garros finalist Daria Gavrilova (RUS); world No. 4 Tímea Babos (HUN); Yulia Putintseva (RUS), who has reached two finals on the Italian clay this year, winning one title; and 2009 US Open finalist Yana Buchina (RUS).

Fucsovics, the world No. 6, returns to ITF junior competition after his run to the Australian Open semifinals in January. The Hungarian has proved his pedigree with titles on all surfaces in the past year and will be favourite to add to his trophy collection in Milan. Another Hungarian, world No. 7 Mate Zsiga, has won two titles so far this year and shown he can compete with the best on the red clay.

The South American charge will be led by Renzo Olivo (ARG), who has a 23-4 record for the year so far, and Copa Gerdau semifinalist Duilio Beretta (PER). Others to watch are Wimbledon doubles champion Kevin Krawietz (GER) and Jiri Vesely (CZE), who has one title on clay this year and was runner-up at the Copa Gerdau. Kunieda, di Toro, Wagner win Japan Open titles

Japan's Shingo Kunieda, Daniela di Toro of Australia and American David Wagner won the singles titles at last week's Japan Wheelchair Open in Iizuka, the second Super Series event of the 2010 NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour.

World No. 1 Kunieda and No. 2 Stephane Houdet of France both eased into the men's singles final without dropping a set, where Kunieda won the first nine games en route to a 6-0, 6-4 victory, extending his unbeaten run to 87 matches.

Thailand's Sakhorn Khanthasit made the early headlines in the women's singles, the former world No. 6 upsetting two seeds en route to the semifinals, before losing out to di Toro 7-5, 2-6, 6-3. Dutch top seed Sharon Walraven reached the final without dropping a set, but was put under pressure by di Toro from the start as the Australian clinched a 6-2, 6-4 victory for her sixth Japan Open title.

World No. 2 Wagner dominated the quad singles, sealing his third successive Japan Open title with a 6-0, 6-0 victory over Canadian second seed Sarah Hunter.

In the three doubles finals, Japanese top seeds Kunieda and Satoshi Saida whitewashed Frederic Cattaneo and Nicolas Peifer of France 6-0, 6-0; Walraven partnered Khanthasit to a 6-0, 6-2 win over Kanako Domori (JPN) and Myung-Hee Hwang (KOR) 6-0, 6-2; while Wagner and fellow American Bryan Barten defeated Hunter and Andres Hard (SWE) 6-2, 6-1. Further nations qualify for ITF junior team finals

The final Asia/Oceania qualifying event for the 2010 ITF junior team competitions was staged in Anqing City, China last week, with 15 girls' teams contesting four spots in the World Junior Tennis Finals in Prostějov. China defeated Korea to win the event, with both teams qualifying for the finals alongside losing semifinalists Australia and Japan.

The South America qualifying event for the World Junior Tennis competition also took place last week in Bauru, Brazil. Ten boys' and girls' teams both competed for three places at the Finals in Prostějov. Brazil won the girls' event and will be joined in the Finals by runner-up Paraguay and third placed Colombia. Chile won the boys' event to qualify for the Finals and will be joined by runner-up Argentina and third placed Venezuela.



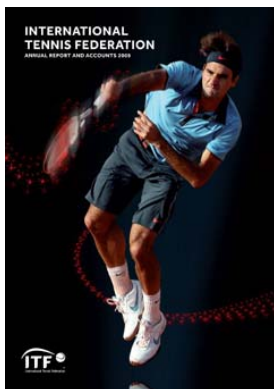

Qualification for the World Junior Tennis Finals has now been completed on all continents except Europe, where the European Summer Cups will serve as qualifying events. The finals of the boys' Copa del Sol and girls' Europa Cup, to be held on 2-4 July, will determine the remaining five boys' and girls' teams to qualify for Prostějov.

Action continues this week with the Junior Davis and Fed Cup by BNP Paribas South American qualifying event in Asuncion, Paraguay.
