Lyon and Belgrade to host Davis Cup semifinals

The Davis Cup by BNP Paribas World Group semifinal between France and Argentina will take place in Lyon, while the Serbia versus Czech Republic tie will be held in Belgrade. Both match-ups will take place on 17-19 September alongside eight World Group play-off ties.

The semifinal in Lyon will be held at the Palais des Sports de Gerland on an indoor hard court, with a seating capacity of 6,000. This is the first time the arena has staged Davis Cup since the historic 1991 Final, when current captain Guy Forget and Henri Leconte teamed up for a 3-1 victory over a strong American side that included Andre Agassi and Pete Sampras. This was France's first victory in the competition since 1932, but the team has gone on to further titles in 1996 and 2001.

France has won all four previous meetings against Argentina, although the two nations have not met since 1982, when France scored a 3-2 World Group first round victory in Buenos Aires.

A temporary hard court will be laid inside the Belgrade Arena which has a seating capacity of 18,200. The venue was used in the first round this year when Serbia saw off USA on clay in front of a near capacity crowd to reach its first Davis Cup quarterfinal. The Serbian team has continued to make history by reaching its first semifinal with a decisive win over Croatia in Split.

Czech Republic holds a 5-4 head-to-head advantage over Serbia however these nations have not faced each other since Czech Republic formed part of Czechoslovakia and Serbia was part of Yugoslavia. Further information about all of September's ties can be found at www.daviscup.com.

Scheffers, Vergeer and Andersson take wheelchair titles

Second seed Maikel Scheffers of the Netherlands won his first ITF Super Series title on Sunday at the 21st British Open, part of the NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour, in Nottingham. His compatriot Esther Vergeer won her tenth title in Nottingham and Sweden's Johan Andersson won his first quad singles title there and his second Super Series title overall.

World No. 4 Scheffers overcame Ronald Vink 62 36 63 in the final, his second victory over his compatriot in as many weeks after beating him in the Swiss Open a week earlier. Top seeded Frenchman Stephane Houdet lost in the quarterfinals to countryman Nicolas Peifer.

Britain's Jordanne Whiley caused the biggest upset in the women's singles, defeating world No. 5 Florence Alix-Gravellier of France in three sets in the quarterfinals, but Whiley posed few problems for Dutch fourth seed Jiske Griffioen in the semifinals. Griffioen put in a fine effort against Vergeer in the second set of the final, but it was to no avail as Vergeer extended her current winning streak to 390 matches after a 61 64 victory.

Top seed and defending champion David Wagner reached the quad singles final against Andersson without dropping a set, but the Swede proved more than his match in the final, earning a 62 36 64 victory to add to the Florida Open Super Series title he won in April.



Europeans fight for Junior Davis Cup/Fed Cup Finals spots

This week's Borotra Cup (boys) and Helvetie Cup (girls) 16 & under team events are acting as the European qualifying events for the Junior Davis Cup and Junior Fed Cup by BNP Paribas Finals in San Luis Potosi, Mexico.

Twenty-nine nations have entered both events. The Borotra Cup qualifying rounds are taking place across four venues on 28-30 July, with the final round held in Le Touquet, France on 2-4 August. France, Serbia, Great Britain and Portugal are top seeds at the four venues. The Helvetie Cup qualifying rounds are also taking place at four venues on 28-30 July, with the final round held in Leysin, Switzerland on 2-4 August. France, Russia, Belarus and Czech Republic top the girls line-up.

Six nations will qualify for both the Junior Davis and Fed Cup Finals in San Luis Potosi on 28 September – 3 October. They will join boys teams from Argentina, Australia, Brazil, Canada, Chile, China, P.R., India, Japan, Mexico and South Africa, and girls teams from Argentina, Australia, Bolivia, China, P.R., Japan, Mexico, Paraguay, Tunisia, USA and Uzbekistan in September's Final.

Last year Australia's boys team overcame a strong challenge from Great Britain to take its sixth crown in the event's 25-year history, while Russia girls overcame Germany to take its second title.
