France and USA top seeds at World Junior Tennis Finals

France boys and USA girls teams are the top seeds at the 20th World Junior Tennis Finals, which got underway today on the clay courts of TK Prostějov in the Czech Republic. For the 12th consecutive year the club is hosting the finals of the ITF's 14-and-under international team competition. Play continues until 7 August.

Sixteen boys and 16 girls teams, from a total of 23 countries, have fought their way through tough regional qualifying competitions for the chance to compete in the Finals. This year saw a record 172 teams from 94 nations competing in the four qualifying events.

This week's event begins with a round-robin competition, with boys and girls teams each being divided into four round-robin groups. The winner of each group qualifies for the knockout semifinals, while the remaining nations contest play-offs to determine their final position.

The boys event will see new a winner crowned as last year's champion Spain failed to qualify for the Finals. France, winner of this year's European Summer Cup, is the competition favourite, while 2008 champion USA is also a strong contender for the title. The 2007 champion Australia is feeling confident having won its regional qualifying event earlier this year.

In the girls event, defending champion USA looks to claim a record fourth consecutive title, while Asian champion China bids to put itself on the map with a first World Junior Tennis title. However they face fierce competition from France and Russia, the latter nation looking to reclaim a title it hasn't won since winning back-to-back events in 1999 and 2000.

Past competitors in this competition include Rafael Nadal, Andy Roddick, Kim Clijsters and Amelie Mauresmo. All players this week will be hoping to emulate their sporting heroes and take their first steps along the road to becoming champions. Success for Nigeria and Ghana on West Africa Circuit

Nigeria and Ghana dominated the ITF/CAT West & Central Africa 12 and 14 & Under Circuit, at the Domaine de Nianing in Senegal. Forty boys and 18 girls from 12 countries participated in the circuit, which comprised a training camp, two four-day tournaments, and a further three days training.

In the 14-and-under age group, Nigeria's Sarah Adegoke won both girls singles titles, while the boys singles titles went to Togo's Batazi Abissoubie and Nigerian Emmanuel Idoko. Adegoke also won both girls' doubles titles with Francisca Nyarko (GHA), while the two boys doubles titles went to Francis Akpese and Abraham Asaba (GHA).

The 12-and-under singles saw two wins for both Isaac Nortey (GHA) and Zainab Oladimeji (NGR). The boys doubles titles were shared between Andrea Dezai and Dieudone Ky (CIV), and Marcel Agbegne and Isaac Nortey (GHA), while there were girls doubles wins for Oladimeji and Crystal Nzewi (NGR), and Ahounou Anicette (BEN) and Rosemary Owusu (GHA).

NEWS IN BRIEF

Molins re-elected COTECC President

Enrique Molins was unanimously re-elected President of the Central American & Caribbean Tennis Confederation (COTECC) at its AGM in San Salvador, El Salvador on 1 August.

Following a presentation by ITF Executive Vice President Juan Margets, a motion was raised and unanimously agreed by 17 COTECC nations to support the four principles for Davis Cup and Fed Cup that had been defined by the ITF Board of Directors and previously supported by the Tennis Europe, Asian Tennis Federation, CAT and COSAT AGMs: played on an annual basis; home-and-away format; in association with National Associations; and conforming to the Rules of Tennis.
