## Juniors start at Flushing Meadows

The US Open Junior Championships started on Sunday with strong boys' and girls' line-ups. Eighteen of the top 20 junior boys started at Flushing Meadows, while the girls' draw included 16 of the top 20.

In the boys' event, Marton Fucsovics (HUN) is hoping to continue his excellent form in Grand Slam events this year after reaching the Australian Open semifinals and claiming the Wimbledon title. He faces tough opposition from a host of contenders, including world No. 1 Juan Sebastian Gomez (COL), fresh from winning the singles gold medal at the inaugural Youth Olympic Games in Singapore. Australian Open champion Tiago Fernandes (BRA) and Roland Garros champion Agustin Velotti (ARG) are also part of a strong South American challenge.

European junior champion Damir Dzumhur (BIH) is hoping to transfer his strong form on clay and grass this summer into a good performance on hard court in his US Open debut. Other boys' players to look out for include Oliver Golding (GBR) and Jiri Vesely (CZE), who clinched doubles gold in Singapore. The pair are bidding to improve on their Grand Slam performances and feature in the latter stages of the US Open for the first time.

In the girls' event, Daria Gavrilova (RUS), who jumped to No. 1 in the junior world rankings after capturing the Youth Olympic Games singles gold medal, goes in search of her first Grand Slam title. European junior champion Jana Cepelova (SVK), another strong performer in Singapore, is looking to better her quarterfinal performance of last year. Karolina and Krystina Pliskova (CZE) form part of a strong challenge from Czech Republic. The twin sisters are bidding to claim a third Grand Slam title of the year for their family, Karolina having won the Australian Open and Krystina at Wimbledon.

Leading the home challenge is Sloane Stephens (USA), twice a Grand Slam doubles champion so far this year with Timea Babos (HUN). Other players to look out for include 2008 Wimbledon champion Laura Robson (GBR) and Ons Jabeur (TUN), the runner-up at Roland Garros and quarterfinalist at Wimbledon.

## St. Louis champions bid for US Open double

Shingo Kunieda, Esther Vergeer and Peter Norfolk bid to defend their wheelchair crowns at the US Open this week fresh from winning the titles at the US Open USTA Wheelchair Championships. The tournament in St. Louis is the final Super Series event of the 2010 NEC Wheelchair Tennis Tour.

Kunieda clinched his 100<sup>th</sup> successive singles victory when defeating world No. 7 Nicolas Peifer (FRA) 62 61 in the men's quarterfinals. The Japanese player was presented with the match scorecard and a ball etched with the number 100 afterwards in recognition of his achievement. He followed up with another 61 62 victory over sixth seed Ronald Vink (NED) in the semifinals, and raised his level still higher to beat world No. 5 Robin Ammerlaan (NED) 60 61 in the final.

## US Open wheelchair preview (cont. from page 1)

It was business as usual for Vergeer, who had won her 100<sup>th</sup> successive tournament and the 27<sup>th</sup> Super Series title of her career in her last competitive outing at the British Open in July. The Dutch star dropped just seven games in three matches en route to winning her ninth title at the event, beating unseeded compatriot Jiske Griffioen 62 61 in the final.

Like Kunieda and Vergeer, Norfolk will arrive in New York as the world No. 1, having dropped behind American David Wagner during five months out of the sport to concentrate on his family life. However, after becoming a father for the second time in July, the British player had already ensured he would reclaim the top spot from Wagner in his comeback tournament before beating him 76(7) 67(3) 62 in the quad singles final in St. Louis.

Ammerlaan and Vink eased to the men's doubles titles, while Griffioen partnered fellow Dutchwoman Sharon Walraven to victory in the women's doubles. Nick Taylor paired up with Wagner as the Americans retained their quad doubles title

As the world's top players descend on New York for the last Grand Slam tournament of the year, Kunieda heads a men's field consisting of seven of the world's top eight players. The women's field also features seven of the world's top eight, including French former world No. 2 Florence Alix-Gravellier, for whom the US Open will be the last tournament of her career before retiring. Norfolk and Wagner are set to renew their rivalry in a quad singles field that features the world's top four players.

## NEWS IN BRIEF

### McEnroe to step down as U.S. captain

Patrick McEnroe will resign as U.S. Davis Cup captain immediately after the USA's Davis Cup by BNP Paribas World Group play-off tie with Colombia, it was announced today.

McEnroe is the longest serving captain in U.S. Davis Cup history, with 2010 being his tenth successive year in the role. He led the U.S. to its record 32<sup>nd</sup> Davis Cup title in 2007, its first title since 1995. He has compiled a 16-9 record ahead of the play-off tie in Bogota, and his 16 victories are second only to Tom Gorman's 18 wins in U.S. Davis Cup history.

"It is with a heavy heart that I am resigning as Davis Cup captain, but it is a decision I felt was best for the team and myself right now," McEnroe said. "Davis Cup is a significant time commitment and this decision will allow me to focus more energy on my family and to the USTA Player Development program"

"Patrick is the one the finest and most decorated captains in U.S. Davis Cup history," said Lucy S. Garvin, Chairman of the Board and President, USTA. "He leaves an indelible mark on the Davis Cup, and has always handled his captaincy with class and distinction. Patrick is and will remain a tremendous asset to U.S. tennis as he continues to lead our player development efforts."
