USA dominates ITF Super-Seniors World Team Championships

USA dominated the ITF Super-Seniors World Team Championships in Antalya, Turkey last week, claiming six of the nine titles on offer and reaching the final of the other three events.

In the men's team events USA successfully defended the Britannia (men's 65) and Bitsy Grant Cups (men's 75). In the Britannia Cup, USA wasted little time securing victory over France with straight-sets wins in the two singles rubbers. It was an equally ruthless display in the Bitsy Grant Cup, defeating Germany, winning the two singles rubbers for the loss of only two games.

The third American victory came in the Von Cramm Cup (men's 60), defeating Spain in a reverse of last year's final. The match went right down to the deciding doubles where USA came back from a set down to win in the third set tiebreak.

USA was defeated in the finals of the other two men's cups. In the Jack Crawford Cup (men's 70) Austria clinched the trophy with a 2-1 victory after a strong performance in the decisive doubles rubber. Canada reached its first ever Gardner Mulloy Cup final (men's 80) and recorded a 2-1 victory to clinch the trophy with Lorne Main winning the second singles rubber.

In the women's events USA continued its success, winning the Alice Marble Cup (women's 60) for the first time since 1997. USA also looked set to take the Kitty Godfree Cup (women's 65) before Great Britain came from 1-0 down to clinch victory in the deciding doubles and successfully defend its title. The two countries also met in the final of the Queens' Cup (women's 75) where convincing victories in the opening two singles rubbers ensured victory for the Americans.

The singles rubbers were shared in the Althea Gibson Cup (women's 70) final between USA and Germany before the German team had to retire through injury in the doubles to give USA its sixth cup of the championships.

The Super-Seniors World Individual Championships are taking place this week with many of the team competitors staying in Antalya to chase individual glory. Daily updates are available on www.itftennis.com/seniors.

Bopanna and Qureshi receive award

Peace and Sport announced last week that a photograph of Rohan Bopanna and Aisam-Ul-Haq Qureshi has received the Peace and Sport Image of the Year award.

The Indian-Pakistani doubles pairing have been playing together for three years and reached the final of this year's US Open, where they were watched by their respective United Nations ambassadors Hardeep Puri and Abdullah Haroon. Over the course of their partnership the duo has managed to bring the political authorities in their respective countries closer.

Bopanna and Qureshi will receive the award, along with representatives from their countries' authorities, during the Gala Evening of the 4th International Forum Peace and Sport, which will take place on 2 December in Monaco. For more information visit www.peace-sport.org.

Puig heads Osaka Mayor's Cup entry

Monica Puig heads the girls' entry list for the Osaka Mayor's Cup, the penultimate Grade A of the year on the ITF Junior Circuit, which gets underway on Monday.

The Puerto Rican is looking for her second Grade A title of the year, after winning the Gerdau Cup in March. The world No. 5 has also reached the final of the Casablanca Cup and the Italian Open this year, as well as appearing in the quarter-finals at Roland Garros and the US Open. She has been one of the most consistent performers in top level events in 2010 and is favourite to take the title in Osaka.

Puig's main competition could come from China's Saisai Zheng, the Youth Olympic Games silver medallist. Zheng defeated Puig at the Youth Olympics and definitely has a strong chance of winning her first Grade A title.

Japanese hopes rest with Asian Closed champion Miho Kowase and her compatriot Eri Hozumi, runner up at the Grade 1 Japan Junior Open earlier this year.

The Japanese fans will also be closely watching the stars of their Junior Davis Cup by BNP Paribas team, who brought home the trophy two weeks ago for the first time in their country's history. Kaichi Uchida, Soichiro Moritani and Kazuma Kawachi will all be looking to continue their good form in their home event.

Top seed in the boys' event will be Croatian Mate Pavic, who will be looking for his third title of the year after two Grade 2 wins in South Africa. His closest challenger could be another Japanese player, world No. 22 Yasutaka Uchiyama, who took a wild card into the tournament. China's Bowen Ouyang, the Asian Closed champion, and Sean Berman (USA), who reached the final of the Australian Open at the start of the year, must also be considered strong contenders.
