Italy and USA to host semifinals

Italy and USA will host the semifinals of the 2010 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas after the two nations scored impressive World Group first round victories away from home on 6-7 February. Defending champion Italy overcame Ukraine 4-1 in Kharkiv, while USA saw off France by the same scoreline in Lievin.

In the semifinals, held on 24-25 April, Italy will be at home to Czech Republic who scored a dramatic 3-2 victory over Germany in Brno. USA will host Russia, who also needed a deciding doubles to see off Serbia 3-2 in the weekend's feature tie in Belgrade. For further information, visit www.fedcup.com and www.fedcup.com/es.

The four World Group first round losers will contest the World Group Play-offs, also on 24-25 April, alongside the four World Group II winners, Australia, Belgium, Estonia and Slovak Republic. Australia edged out Spain 3-2 in Adelaide; Belgium saw off Poland 3-2 in Bydgoszcz; Estonia enjoyed a comfortable 4-1 victory over Argentina in Tallinn; while Slovak Republic was too strong for China, winning 3-2 in Bratislava.

The four World Group II first round losers will contest the World Group II Play-offs on 24-25 April alongside the four qualifiers from last week's Fed Cup Zonal Group I events: Canada (Americas Zone), Japan (Asia/Oceania Zone), Slovenia and Sweden (Europe/Africa Zone). Thirty-nine-year-old Kimiko Date-Krumm made a successful return to the Japan team after an absence of 14 years, winning all four singles rubbers contested during the week-long event.

Twenty-year-old Alisa Kleybanova became Russia's latest heroine as the visitors saw off a strong Serbian challenge and 11,000 fans at the Belgrade Arena. Jelena Jankovic put the home team in a strong position with battling three-set victories over Kleybanova and world No.4 Svetlana Kuznetsova. However Kleybanova then saw off Ana Ivanovic 62 63, before partnering Kuznetsova to a 61 64 deciding doubles victory over Ivanovic and Jankovic.

Kleybanova said: "Saturday was a very tough day but I'm happy I recovered well and I was performing pretty good today. It is most important that we won the whole match and I am very happy."

Russia's reward is a trip to USA in the semifinals, after the Americans were too strong for France in Lievin. Eighteen-year-old Melanie Oudin, winner of the 2009 Fed Cup by BNP Paribas Heart Award, was the architect of the US triumph, posting straight sets victories over Pauline Parmentier and Julie Coin to secure a 3-0 winning lead. Earlier Bethanie Mattek-Sands had put the visitors in front with a shock 76 75 win over French No. 1 Alize Cornet.

"I'm so proud of my team," said US captain Mary Joe Fernandez. "It's all about the team chemistry and wanting to do well not just for yourself but for your teammates and your country. They get out there and work hard to be their best on a given day. The rankings aren't always the most important factor when you play for your country."

Italy remains the team to beat in Fed Cup, the title holder scoring its fifth consecutive win in the competition away in Ukraine. Alona Bondarenko put the home team in front with victory over Francesca Schiavone, but Italian No. 1 Flavia Pennetta then scored straight sets wins over both Bondarenko sisters. It was left to Schiavone to complete the visitors' triumph, the 29-year-old coming from a set down to defeat Kateryna Bondarenko 26 61 61.

Italy will now host Czech Republic, who reached the semifinals for the second successive year with a dramatic 3-2 win over Germany in Brno. The star of the Czech triumph was 24-year-old debutant Lucie Hradecka, who was brought in on the second day with the tie all-square. Hradecka defeated Andrea Petkovic 61 76(6) to put the hosts in front, before partnering Kveta Peschke to a 61 63 deciding doubles victory over Anna-Lena Groenefeld and Tatjana Malek.

Italy and Russia retain their top two positions on the latest ITF Fed Cup Nations Ranking. Czech Republic climbs one place to No. 4, and Belgium rises four positions to No. 6. The Fed Cup Nations Ranking is published following every Fed Cup round.
