

Turville, Pokorny, Fales and Main shine at ITF Super-Seniors World Championships

Four competitors stood out at last week's ITF Super-Seniors World Individual Championships held in Antalya, Turkey. Lawrence Turville (USA), Peter Pokorny (AUT), Donna Fales (USA) and Lorne Main (CAN) completed a hat trick of victories with success in the team cup, singles and doubles for their respective age categories. A total of 462 players from 32 countries took part in the prestigious event for players aged 60-and-over to 85-and over.

Turville followed up his victory with the USA in the Von Cramm Cup the week previously with a win in the Men's 60 singles, defeating Jorge Camina Borda (ESP) 62 64. He then teamed up with compatriot Neal Newman to win the Men's 60 doubles.

Pokorny achieved the same feat, following up Austria's success in the Jack Crawford Cup with victory in the Men's 70 singles and doubles. He won the singles title for the loss of only three games and teamed with compatriot Peter Kruck to seal the doubles. Pokorny has now captured 13 seniors world championship titles.

Fales was part of the triumphant American team that won the Althea Gibson Cup and continued her success in the individual championships. She defeated Janine Lieffrig (RSA) 61 61 in the Women's 70 singles final before teaming up with compatriot Doris DeVries to clinch the doubles.

The fourth player to complete a treble of victories was Canada's Main. In his first year in the Men's 80's age category Main guided his country to victory in the Gardner Mulloy Cup before clinching his 12th World Championships singles and 13th doubles titles. In the Men's 80 singles final he defeated American Russell Seymour 61 61 before teaming up with Ken Sinclair to defeat Seymour once more in the doubles final.

A number of players successfully defended their titles at the Ali Bey Club. King Van Nostrand (USA) won the Men's 75 singles to clinch his third consecutive world title, and in a repeat of last year's final Ellie Krocke (NED) defeated Heidi Orth (GER) to claim the Women's 65 singles crown. Australian Neville Halligan retained both his singles and doubles titles in the Men's 85 age category.

Elizabeth Allan (AUS) claimed the Women's 60's singles title, defeating German Heidi Eisterlehner 63 64 in the final, but failed in her quest to claim an historic 18th consecutive World Championships doubles title, losing in the semifinals.

Petr Kolacek (SUI) and Burnett Herrick (USA) won their first-ever world championship titles. Kolacek defeated top seed Peter Adrigan (GER) in the Men's 65 singles final and Herrick added the Women's 75 singles crown to her success in last week's Queen's Cup.

Home victory for Uchiyama at Osaka Mayor's Cup

The Osaka Mayor's Cup, the penultimate junior Grade A event of the year, finished on Sunday with Japan's Yasutaka Uchiyama and China's Saisai Zheng both capturing maiden Grade A titles.

Uchiyama delighted home fans with a 64 16 63 victory over Croatia's Mate Pavic in the final, having had to fight through several tough matches en route. The Japanese boy needed just the one break to secure the first set before Pavic pulled away in the second set to level the match. Uchiyama then found form to take the third set and the title. "I'm very happy for having won the Osaka Mayors Cup - it was a very tough match against Mate," he said. "I tried to concentrate doing the best I can."

Zheng, girls' runner-up at the Youth Olympic Games in Singapore, stormed through

to Sunday's final without the loss of a set, before coming up against Japan's Miho Kowase. Second seed Zheng took the first set of the final 75 before Kowase found her groove to take the second set 76. The pair were then forced to move inside after a turn in the weather, with Zheng finally prevailing in a nail-biting third set tiebreak to become the first Chinese player to win the Osaka Mayor's Cup. "It was a very tough match against Kowase. My opponent was really a good player and I was fortunate to win with a little point of difference," she said.

The home crowd were treated to further Japanese success as Miyu Kato and Eri Hozumi claimed the girls' doubles title over the Russian pairing of Daria Salnikova and Ekaterina Semanova 64 16 [10-6]. In the boys' doubles, Pavic made up for his loss in the singles final by claiming the boys' doubles title with singles victor Uchiyama, over the Swedish pair of Morgan Johansson and Stefan Lindmark 61 64.
