Vergeer bidding for 400th straight win in Amsterdam

Esther Vergeer is looking to extend her incredible winning streak beyond 400 matches this week when the NEC Wheelchair Tennis Singles Masters takes place in Amsterdam.

Not only is Vergeer currently unbeaten in 396 matches, she is undefeated at the NEC Masters since her debut in 1998 and after coming within two points of defeat in 2009, she will hope for a more straightforward path this year.

Australian Daniela di Toro is the last player to beat Vergeer, back in January 2003, and arrives in Amsterdam as world No. 2. Meanwhile, Vergeer's countrywomen Jiske Griffioen, Sharon Walraven and Aniek van Koot are aiming to secure an all-Dutch semifinal line-up, with Vergeer needing to win her semifinal to chalk up 400 successive victories.

Former finalists Korie Homan and Florence Alix-Gravellier are both absent from this year's field.

Homan, who threatened Vergeer's superiority in last year's final, is out of the sport with a wrist injury, while Alix-Gravellier retired after the US Open.

Like Vergeer, Japan's Shingo Kunieda has already secured the year-end world No. 1 ranking, but he is attempting to win his first men's title in Amsterdam and claim one of the few accolades in the sport to still elude him.

Kunieda is guaranteed to face a strong Dutch challenge from defending champion Maikel Scheffers and six-time NEC Masters champion and 2009 runner-up, Robin Ammerlaan. After reaching his first Grand Slam final in New York, Nicolas Peifer joins Stephane Houdet to launch the French bid, while 2008 champion Stefan Olsson of Sweden aims to rediscover the form that saw him become the youngest ever winner two years ago.

Britain's Peter Norfolk and America's David Wagner will once again compete for the year-end world No. 1 quad singles ranking in Amsterdam, but world No. 3 Johan Andersson has defeated both players this season and joins American Nick Taylor in a field that boasts four previous finalists.
