

MASTERS – INDIAN CIRCUIT

OVERVIEW

“Rendez-vous à Roland-Garros” (RDVRG)) is the junior tournament on red clay which offers a wildcard for the 2017 French Open Junior Tournament. It will first take place separately in China, India, Brazil, South Korea, Japan & USA. After the first round of competition in each country, the champions will come to Paris for the final round, and the final champion will win this wildcard.

ELIGIBILITY

The RDVRG Masters of Indian Circuit will be invitational for top 8 boys and 8 girls will be selected on the basis of combined AITA points earned by players in the two qualifying AITA National Series tournaments held in Kolkata & Pune. A list so compiled will be available on AITA website by 4th April 2017.

All players are required to send their confirmation in writing by 8th April 2017 on vinit@aitatennis.com. If the selected players do not intimate their acceptance by deadline, next player in the list so prepared will be accepted.

If the ranking of the winner of the RDVRG in India is 45 or higher at the time of the entry closing of Roland Garros, the ticket to Paris will be allocated to the runner up. If the runner up’s ranking is 45 or higher at the time of the entry closing, the ticket to Paris will be allocated to the second runner up and so on.
