The ACTC meeting was held under the Chairmanship of Sh. Ravi Mital, Secretary (Sports) to consider the proposal of ACTC 2020-21 and budget request for All India Tennis Federation (AITA).

2. Sh. Anil Dhupar, Secretary General, AITA briefly explained the performance and achievements of Indian Tennis players and mentioned that Indian Tennis players have secured 03 medals out of 05 participation in Asian Games, 2018. He informed the members that Indian team has qualified for the first time in the World Cup playoff. He also informed regarding the Key Result Areas and Milestones set for the Indian Tennis players up to 2030, which are given below:

3. When asked Secretary General about events for medal prospect in Olympics, it was informed that the Doubles and Mixed Doubles have brightest chance in 2024 & 2028. In view of the same Secretary (sports) desired that Federation may come up with focused planning for development of Doubles and Mixed Doubles including specialized academies etc. also more events for Doubles can be planned & more exposures for Doubles may be considered. Sh. Dhupar promised to give detailed roadmap in January, 2021.
