GUIDELINES ON AGE VERIFICATION

RULES REGARDING SUBMISSION OF TESTIMONIALS AND CERTIFICATES

As per the Registration of Birth and Death Act 1961 it is mandatory to get the births registered within a stipulated period of time with the Registrar of Birth and Death. The act is applicable throughout INDIA.

In order to streamline the ITN registration process, the following rules shall be followed:

- 1. All Birth Certificates issued <u>within one year of birth</u> shall be considered with the ITN application for Registration.
- 2. There should be no overwriting / or cutting on the Birth certificate.
- 3. Any other Date of Birth proof like Passport, School Birth Certificate with photographduly attested by the Principal to be submitted.

FOR ALL BIRTH CERTIFICATES ISSUED AFTER ONE YEAR OF BIRTH, FOLLOWING DOCUMENTS SHALL BE NEEDED:

- 1. Birth Certificate issued by the Registrar of Birth and Death. Documents to be signed/ attested/ verified by Sub Divisional Magistrate confirming Date of Birth.
- 2. Hospital certificate regarding the Birth Date.
- 3. Immunization record card which gives dates of various Injections/ Drops given to the baby.
- 4. The Nursery or KG report card from school first attended which mentions Date of Birth.
- 5. Additional Date of Birth proof like Passport Copy and School Birth Certificate with photograph duly attested by the Principal.
- 6. In case the child/parent do not submit any of the above documents from 1 to 5, then they can submit the DOB certified by the court.
