Practice Timing – 1 Court per Team for 1 hour (Morning & After the Matches)

\Rightarrow **DRAW FORMAT:**

- 16 Men's team / 16 Women's teams will be divided into 4 groups of Men / Women.
- Top 1 team from each group will qualify for semi-finals.
- The winner in the semi-finals tie will play the finals and the loser from the semi-finals will play for 3rd Place
- The tie will consults of 2 singles matches & 1 doubles match

If in the round robin groups the points of the teams are equal, then the positions of the teams will be decided by the highest percentage of set won by the team.

If the percentage of the set won also remain equal, then the highest percentage of games won by the team will be no. 1.

If the percentage of set & games remain the same then the position will be decided by head to head of that team.

\Rightarrow MATCH FORMAT:

Men's & Women's singles matches will be played (Best of 3 Tie-Break Sets)

Men's & Women's doubles matches will be played (Best of 2 Tie-Break Sets and a match Tie-Break {10 point} in place of 3 set, with No-Ad scoring)

\Rightarrow **BALL CHANGE:**

The Ball change for the matches is 11 Games & 13 Games.

⇒ ENTRIES ACCEPTANCE:

Max 9 No. of players are been accepted to participant in the event from the university.

Men's - Max. 5 Players per team. 5 players X 16 Teams = 80 players

Women's - Max. 4 Players per team. 4 players X 16 Teams = 64 players

Total players participants = 144 players

⇒ PLAYERS RANK ORDER:

Capitan's / Managers will have to submit in the team meeting on 27 November 2025 at 15:30 Hrs.

All the team Managers have to submit their players nominations $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before the matches start.

⇒ DRESS CODE FOR MATCHES:

The team should follow the dress code and colour on the day of the matches.
