**Minutes of Meeting for Annual Calendar for Training & Competition (ACTC) for Tennis 2026-27**

A meeting to finalize the Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) for the discipline of Tennis for the financial year 2026-27 was held on 18<sup>th</sup> March, 2026 at 3.30 pm under the Chairpersonship of Shri. Hari Ranjan Rao, Secretary (Sports), Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports (MYA&S), at the Conference Hall, Sports Authority of India (SAI) Headquarters, New Delhi. The list of attendees is placed at *Annexure-I*.

2. All India Tennis Association (AITA) presented a plan towards financial assistance under the ANSFs scheme for holding of Foreign Exposures, Holding of International Competitions in India, Wheelchair National Championship etc. to prepare for various international competitions during 2026-27 for Rs. 9.01.Cr. and subsequently Rs. 9.06 Cr. (*Annexure-III*)

3. At the outset, Secretary General (AITA), presented the Key Result Areas (KRAs) and projected performance targets for the upcoming international competitions, as detailed below:

4. Secretary General, All India Tennis Association made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:

- a. Development of High-Performance Centres (HPCs) across India in coordination with State Associations, with one primary Centre of Excellence supported by 4-5 feeder HPCs across the country.
- b. Promotion of partnerships under the Khelo India Scheme to state associations and private academies, particularly for establishing Khelo India Accredited Academies (KIAAs), with the objective of increasing their number across India and maximising the benefits available under the scheme.
- c. Upgradation of Coaches and Technical officials through structured certification courses, seminars, and capacity-building initiatives, including the engagement of foreign instructors/educators to enhance the quality of coaching in India.
- d. Initiation of a structured developmental programme for Sub-Junior and Junior Athletes aimed at early Talent Identification and building a robust talent pipeline, ultimately facilitating the development of world-class senior athletes, under the monitoring and supervision of a High-Performance Director (HPD).
- e. AITA will submit the Utilisation Certificate (UCs) of grants received under ANSFs scheme in a time bound manner.
- f. Strict compliance of WADA Code and NADA rules, details of educational plans for athletes and display of Anti-Doping awareness programmes on their respective websites.

5. The calendar was considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The budget under the ANSFs scheme for FY 2026-27 towards All India Tennis Association shall be up to **Rs. 10.05 Crores** as per the latest ANSFs norms of MYA&S dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2025. The detailed head wise approval is placed at *Annexure-II*. A Mid-Year Review would be undertaken based on the progress, achievements and targeted preparation for Asian Games 2026. Budget Summary is tabulated below:

6. Secretary (Sports) emphasized the following aspects:
- a. The performance of the Indian Davis Cup team in reaching the Top-16 globally was appreciated; However, the limited bench strength and over-reliance on a few individual athletes were highlighted as key areas of concern.
  - b. The limited number of Khelo India Accredited Academies (KIAAs) despite the presence of approximately 100 Khelo India Athletes (KIAs) in the tennis ecosystem—was highlighted as an area of concern. In this regard, AITA was advised to proactively educate and guide private academies and State Associations to apply for KIAA status. This would facilitate enhanced funding support under the Khelo India Scheme and enable the development of academies into well-rounded training centres with state-of-the-art infrastructure and integrated sports science support.
  - c. The lack of bench strength was also attributed to the dropout of talented junior athletes from the tennis ecosystem, primarily due to inadequate mentorship, financial support, and the absence of a structured development pathway by AITA—an issue of significant concern. In this context, AITA was advised to establish a structured “Junior-to-Professional” development programme, to be led by a High-Performance Director (HPD) for professional and effective implementation. Further, SAI officials were directed to allocate additional funds under the ANSF Scheme to facilitate the engagement of the HPD.
  - d. Further, AITA officials were advised to engage with officials of the National Rifle Association of India (NRAI) to gain insights into the process of hiring a High-Performance Director (HPD) and to study the best practices associated with the effective implementation of the HPD programme.
  - e. AITA was advised to collaborate with private sector/CSR partners and State Governments for the development of High-Performance Centres (HPCs) across India, in coordination with State

Associations. The proposed structure may include a primary Centre of Excellence supported by 4-5 feeder HPCs across the country, while ensuring appropriate regional balance.

- f. Coach upgradation should be prioritised and services of foreign instructors/educators may be utilised for the same.
  - g. Strict compliance with the various circulars and guidelines issued by MYA&S and SAI regarding governance and financial assistance.
  - h. Strict compliance with the MYA&S circular dated 26.02.2015 regarding suo-moto disclosure on the official website about various activities carried out by the AITA.
  - i. Strict adherence to the Selection Guidelines issued by MYAS vide letter No. 12-2/2025-SP-III dated 05<sup>th</sup> March, 2025.
7. In addition to points mentioned above, following observations were also made
- a. As per the existing norms, mandatory 20% of the total approved is to be earmarked for Grassroots Development activities, which have been committed by AITA towards the Sub-Junior and Junior development programme.
  - b. At least 10% of the budget should be spent on capacity building of Coaches, Support Staff and Technical officials, the same has been incorporated in the budget by AITA.
  - c. As per norms, the NSF with more than 10.00 Cr budget should hire a High-Performance Director (HPD), which is committed by AITA.
  - d. Modifications in the calendar can be made by the NSF with the approval of DG SAI within the overall approved budget for the discipline. It is reiterated that all the guidelines mentioned in MYAS circular dated 22<sup>nd</sup> May, 2025 along with modification in the norms will be adhered to.

Conducting anti-doping awareness programmes alongside tournaments to educate players and support staff during tournaments.

- Regular circulation of anti-doping guidelines and updates via email
- Distribution of educational materials to players. (during tournament)

- **Digital Awareness Initiatives**

Dedicated anti-doping section on the AITA website for publishing rules, updates, and educational content
