ACTC 2025-26 for TENNIS

A meeting to finalize the Annual Calendar for Training and Competition (ACTC) of Tennis for the year 2025-26 was held on 26th March, 2025 at 1.30 pm under the Chairpersonship of Smt. Sujata Chaturvedi, Secretary (Sports) MYA&S at the Conference Hall, Sports Authority of India HQ, New Delhi. The list of participants is **Annexed**.

2. AITA presented a plan towards financial assistance under the ANSFs scheme for holding of National Coaching Camps, Foreign Exposures, Holding of International Competitions in India, equipment requirement etc. to prepare for various international competitions during 2025-26. **(Details annexed)**

3. Treasurer, AITA made following commitments, which were included as binding decisions as a part of approved ACTC calendar and budget:

- 3.1 Conduct of more number of international competitions in India.
- 3.2 Gender & Age group budgeting to be done so as to ensure equal expenditure for Men and Women throughout all the categories.
- 3.3 Strict compliance of WADA Code and NADA rules, details of educational plans for athletes and display of Anti-Doping awareness programmes on their respective websites.
- 3.4 Partnership for various programs under Khelo India.
- 3.5 Coaches' upgradation through outreach activities.

4. The calendar was considered and approved with modifications pursuant to deliberations. The budget under the ANSFs scheme for FY 2025-26 towards AITA shall be up to **Rs. 9.00 Crores** as per the latest ANSFs norms of MYA&S dated 28th February 2022. The disbursement of funds under the ANSFs scheme will be subject to the directions issued by the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in WP (C) No. 8691/2020. A review would be undertaken in the month of **October-November 2025**, based on the progress, achievements and targeted preparation for Asian Games 2026, for any additional requirement of funds subject to availability of budget under the 'Assistance to NSF' Scheme.

5. Modifications in the calendar can be made by the NSF with the approval of DG SAI within the overall approved budget. It is reiterated that all the guidelines mentioned in MYAS circular dated 28th February 2022 along with modification in the norms will be adhered to.


6. Secretary (Sports) emphasised on the following aspects:

- a. AITA was advised to explore CSR partnerships, with a recommendation to establish long-term, sustainable training centre across India.
- b. Strict compliance to the various circulars and guidelines issued by MYA&S and SAI regarding governance and financial assistance.
- c. Strict compliance to the MYA&S circular dated 31.10.2016 regarding suo-moto disclose, on its website about the details of various activities carried out by the AITA.
- d. Strict adherence to the selection guidelines issued by MYAS vide letter no. 12-2/2025-SP-III, dated 05th March, 2025.

- e. AITA should prepare the roadmap for making India as developed nation in Tennis by 2047 which also includes preparation of Asian Games 2026 followed by Olympic 2028, 2032 & 2036 with detailed training plan. AITA should also make complete plan for excellence in 2032 & 2036 Olympics which includes strengthening of junior development programme, robust domestic competition structure in lines with best practices in the world, Coach development plan to reduce reliance on foreign Coaches, Referees'/Judges' development, Athlete education, Grass root development plan, etc. Complete plan may be submitted by 30th May 2025, post which separate discussion would be held.
 - f. Training and Competitions for athletes should cater for adequate recovery and peaking at the right time to ensure maximum medal probability.
7. The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
