Dear All,

Please find attached the first draft of the suggested amendments to the AITA Constitution. The document contains four columns capturing:

- i. The present Rule, Regulation, or Bye-Law in the AITA Constitution;*
- ii. The suggested redraft of the Rule, Regulation, or Bye-Law;*
- iii. Reference to the relevant provisions of the National Sports Governance Act, 2025 and the National Sports Governance (National Sports Bodies) Rules, 2026; and*
- iv. The rationale for the proposed amendment.*

The rows highlighted in green indicate the provisions where changes to the present Rules, Regulations, or Bye-Laws have been suggested.

While proposing the amendments, effort is being made to ensure compliance with the National Sports Governance Act, 2025, the National Sports Governance (National Sports Bodies) Rules, 2026, the judgments of the Supreme Court of India as well as the High Courts and international instruments.

The Administrator has further examined provisions incorporated by other sports bodies such as the All India Football Federation and the Board of Control for Cricket in India, which have withstood judicial scrutiny before the Supreme Court of India.

While undertaking this exercise, every effort has been made to ensure strict compliance with the timeline prescribed by the High Court of Delhi in its order dated 27.04.2026 passed in W.P.(C) 13458/2024.

In the interest of time, this first draft is being circulated at this stage. Simultaneously, the same is also being examined by the Committee of Experts appointed by the Administrator vide directions dated 12.05.2026, which have also been uploaded on the website of AITA.

You are requested to closely scrutinise the proposed amendments and provide your suggestions, wherever necessary, within one week from today, i.e., by 01.06.2026. Suggestions to the attached Word document may be incorporated by adding a fifth column after the existing four columns.

A separate email address has been created for the purpose of receiving suggestions and comments on the first draft of the proposed amendments to the AITA Constitution, so as to avoid cluttering the present email address. **You are requested to send your suggestions and comments on the attached document to the following email address: aitabyelaws@gmail.com**



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Before finalising the proposed amendments, the Administrator may circulate further drafts incorporating such suggestions which are deemed fit for incorporation. A virtual brainstorming session would also be organised after considering the suggestions.
